TRAVEL:

There are two main routes from the city center to QTSC:

- From Nguyễn Văn Trỗi Street -> Cộng Hòa Street -> Trường Chinh Street -> Nguyễn Văn Quá Street (or Highway No.1) -> Quang Trung Street
- From Hai Bà Trưng Street -> Nguyễn Kiệm Street -> Quang Trung Street.

The distance from the city center to QTSC is approximately 16km. You can travel by taxi, bus, motorbike or motorbike taxi (xe ôm).

- **Popular taxi companies:** Vinasun (08) 38272727, Vina taxi (08) 38111111, Festival (08) 38456456. Price range: VND10,000 – VND10,500/km.
- **Bus:** there are many bus routes from the city center to QTSC. It takes about 1 hour to travel by bus. However, specific travel time depends on each departure (30 minutes apart). One way ticket price is VND3,000. The main bus stop is at Bến Thành market, District 1. You can buy monthly ticket or group ticket if you travel regularly. - **Motorbike taxi (xe ôm):** about VND40,000 – VND50,000 per trip.

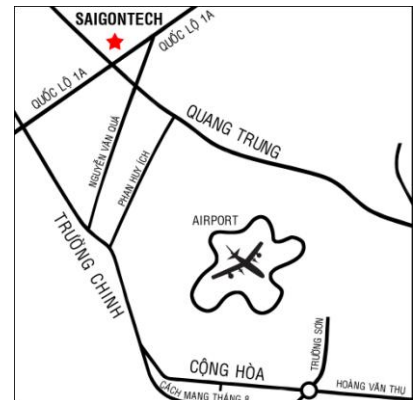


DINING SERVICES

If you are not a local resident of HCMC, housing is a matter of special importance when you study in this city. It is very convenient if you have relatives or acquaintances who let you stay at their home. However, you will need to find accommodation for yourself in most cases. You can live by yourself or share a room, an apartment or a house with your friends. Living on your own is generally more expensive. Usually the more people you live with, the less it will cost. If you choose to study at Truong Dinh or Cong Hoa campus, you have to rent a room, an apartment or a house. There are two options for you to consider: SaigonTech dormitory or other rented accommodation.

DORMITORY

SaigonTech dormitory is located in Quang Trung Software City, about 300m from SaigonTech's main campus. Electricity and water supply are available. Every room in the dormitory is equipped with a separate bathroom, an electric fan and a bed. Some rooms are equipped with an air-conditioner, and a hot water. There are rooms for 2 people, 4 people or 10 people to share. Monthly rental ranges from VND450,000/person to VND750,000/person (utilities not included). Living in SaigonTech dormitory you can take advantage of QTSC's excellent security environment as well as SaigonTech's facilities.

RENTING A HOUSE

In case you want to rent a place outside QTSC, you should consult a map and consider where in Ho Chi Minh City you might want to live. Think about how far you want to travel. Living closer to the school will save your time spent on traveling each day, especially in the heat of a dazzling sunny day. For your convenience, it is recommended that you should live within 5 - 7 km of SaigonTech. You can look for accommodation in the surrounding districts of SaigonTech such as District 12, Go Vap, Tan Binh and Tan Phu Districts. However, remember to check the distance in the map as some districts are vast and it may take 30 minutes to travel by motorbike to SaigonTech, which you might not want to do. However, distance and time sometimes do not matter much in Ho Chi Minh City due to its frequent traffic jams. Therefore, you might want to check out first to avoid also the roads with frequent and severe traffic congestion.

Information about accommodation is available on "Mua & Ban" newspaper, or on its website: www.muaban.net. In the near future, SaigonTech will be collecting and posting information on houses for rent in the neighborhood of Quang Trung campus in order to help you save time in looking for accommodation.

Monthly housing rental varies according to a number of factors, such as:

- Size of the house.
- Location.
- Condition of the house.
- Additional features (fully or not fully furnished, with or without an air-conditioner).

The average monthly rental for average accommodation (utilities not included) in the neighboring districts of SaigonTech is:

- **Type 1:** 12m² room (with separate bathroom, unfurnished, un-air conditioned): VND400 thousand to VND800 thousand.
- **Type 2:** Semi-detached house (with a bedroom, a living room, a kitchen, a bathroom, unfurnished, un-air conditioned): VND1.5 million to VND2.5 million.
- **Type 3:** Room in a guesthouse or a hotel (with separate bathroom, fully furnished, air-conditioned): VND1.5 million to VND2.5 million.
- **Type 4:** Three-bedroom semi-detached house (unfurnished): VND3.0 million to VND4.0 million.

At the start of your tenancy, you will need enough money to pay both the first month's rent and a deposit (usually the amount of a month's rent).

WEATHER INFORMATION

There are two seasons in Ho Chi Minh City: dry season and rainy season. Dry season lasts from November to April, during which period temperature ranges from 20 C to 37 C and it is normally hot and dry in daytime. Rainy season begins in from May and lasts up to October with typical sudden heavy rains. Average temperature is 26 C. In general, Ho Chi Minh City has a tropical climate. It is usually sunny but you still feel comfortable thanks to the influence of the sea. The humidity is 80%, lower than that of other areas in Vietnam.

Clothing: Due to the characteristics of the tropical climate of Ho Chi Minh City, which is warm throughout the year, you should wear clothes made of cotton with bright colors which are suitable for summer. However, you should have with you a thin long-sleeved jacket to keep you warm when it turns a bit colder at night, or to protect your skin when you are exposed to the sweltering sun in the daytime. Remember to bring a raincoat with you in rainy season because heavy rains may come unexpectedly at any time..

AT SAIGONTECH

Certain kinds of part-time jobs are available for students at SaigonTech: flyers and brochures distributions, registrar job for evening shifts, and lab supervision. Payment varies depending on kinds of jobs and working hours. Information on part-time jobs is posted on SaigonTech notice boards or made available at the Office of Registration and Records.

OUTSIDE SAIGONTECH

Tutoring

You can tutor individual students or small groups of students from grade 1 to 12. Payment for tutoring one student is around VND800,000 to VND1,000,000/month. Usually, you can manage to have enough time to tutor two students at the same time. The advantage of this job is that you can make use of your knowledge and use your time in a flexible way. However, you should consider the fact that students' parents always expect the tutoring to produce good results right away on their children's academic transcript, which is out of your control.

Service staff

You can work as a waiter or waitress in restaurants or coffee shops, or receptionist or cash register in hotels. Payment for these kinds of jobs varies from around VND800,000 to VND1,500,000/month. You are not required to have many skills, however, the jobs take a lot of your time, especially in the evening or at night. It is inconvenient that you have to get back home late at night and do not have enough time to do your homework or review your lessons.

Marketing

You can engage in flyer or promotional merchandise distribution or marketing staff. This is a seasonal job and depends on the promotion campaign; therefore, the income is not stable. The disadvantage of this job is that you have to travel a lot, and sometimes to remote and unsafe areas to have access to every household. You might confront uncomfortable circumstances like being teased, scolded at or harassed.

These kinds of jobs are usually available in the Vacant column of such newspapers as Mua & Ban and Viec Lam (published every Sunday).

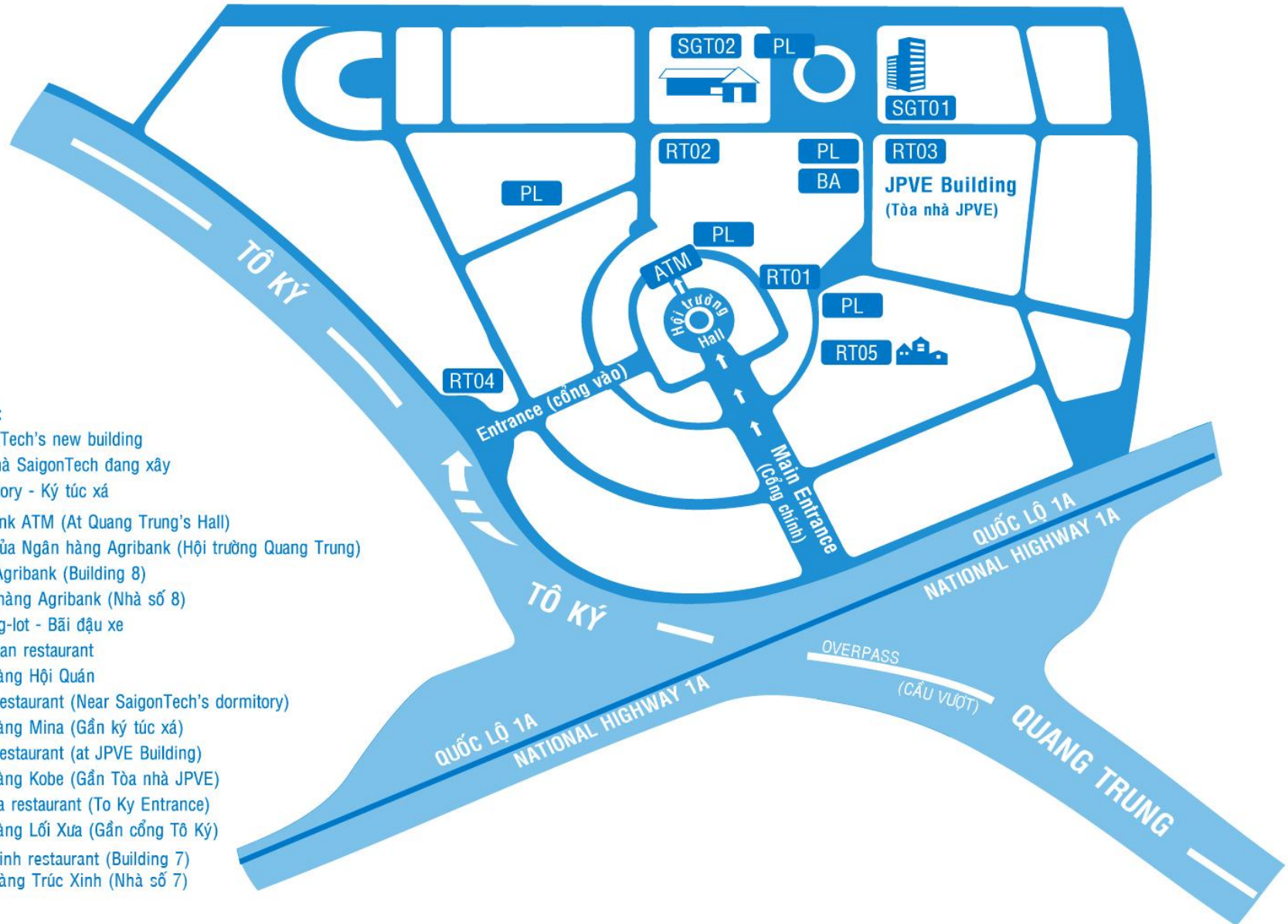
